The discussions will focus on the diverse aspects of support to civil society organisations in the region in contributing to the CONFINTEA process and building grounds for a regional report on relevant topics of the Belem Framework for Action: policy, governance, financing, quality, participation.

During a side event, we'll also discuss how EAEA can work closer with members from outside the EU.

Throughout five days of input sessions, interactive workshops and study visits, the participants will reflect on key issues in adult education, such as advocacy and sustainability, fitting their national or local context into the larger European picture.
