Some facts on LLW(s)

- Since 1996 – major awareness-raising campaign
- National coordination by SIAE
- From one week to five weeks (September, May/June, September/October)
- Country-wide abundance:
 - in 1996: around 70 providers, 500 events
 - in 2019: around 1,900 providers, 7,500 events
 - in 2020: around 1,000 providers, 3,000 events
- Learning Parade – Day(s) of learning communities (on ave. 15)
- **National LLW opening and presentation of awards**
- **Adult Education Colloquium**



Main features

- Coverage of 'life-long' and 'life-wide' learning
- Stable, committed and creative network of LLW coordinators
- Partnerships across all levels – joint actions
- Synthesis of centralised and decentralised approach
- Mixture of 'top-down' and 'bottom-up'
- Learners' voice: 208 award winners, i.e. so called learning champions and ambassadors
- Web-based monitoring and evaluation system
- Relatively sound support by the state



Learning Parade – Day(s) of learning communities

- Developed under the implementation of the EAAL in 2013-2015
 - Now supported by the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport as a constituent part of LLW
 - Strengthened ties among partners at local level – joint endeavours
 - Successful outreach – many new people attracted to learning
 - Learners had their say in shaping events, on stage and in media
 - Municipalities have gained new interest in adult/lifelong learning
 - Learning communities have been identified as a new culture of living
- all resulting in year-round cooperation.**





Celebrating in spite of Covid-19

- May/June → 4 September-9 October
- Uncertainty: accept, adapt, join forces, don't give up ...
- Creative freedom within (safety) limits:
 - Pre-registration of participants, smaller groups, in sequences ...
 - Outdoor activities, several locations, events without audience ...
 - Safety measures: masks, distance, disinfection ...
 - Motivation of providers/partners, concise guidelines ...
- Less partners but more flexible, innovative, committed ones.
- Instead of interactions – separate actions with a ,red thread‘.

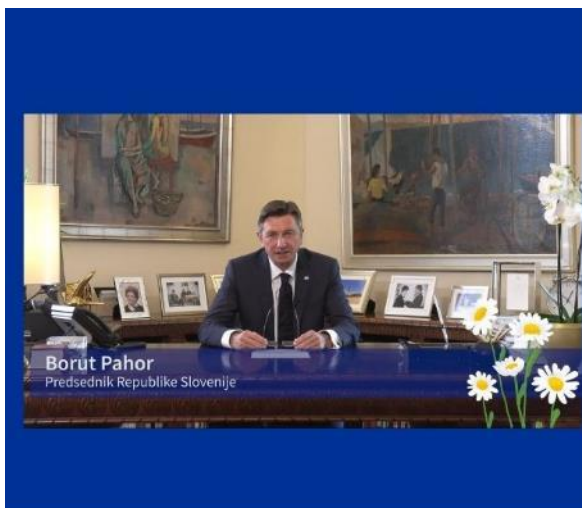


Celebrating in spite of Covid-19


- More digital/virtual solutions – preparatory and implementation phase.
- Filming of events – distribution via YouTube, webpage, smart phone, platforms such as Zoom etc.
- Durability of recordings – recycling in the long run.
- Virtual lectures, workshops, exhibitions, fashion show ...
- Larger audience (joining in from their comfort-zones).
- Excellent media coverage – positive news, inspiring stories ...

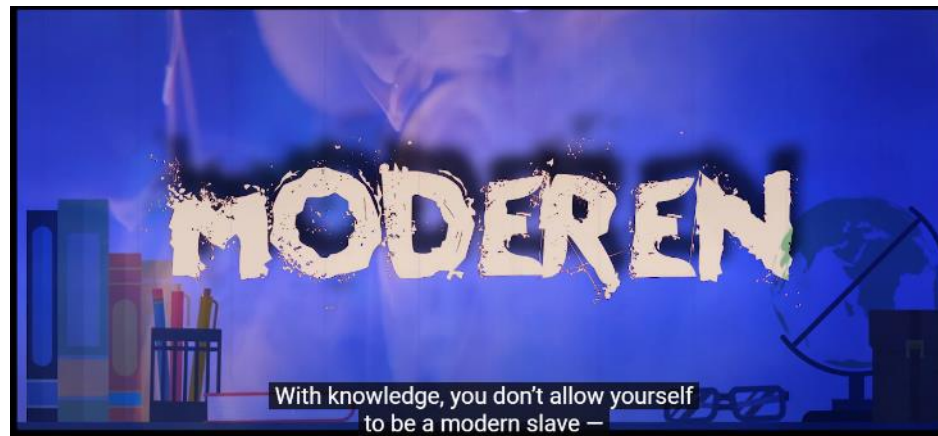
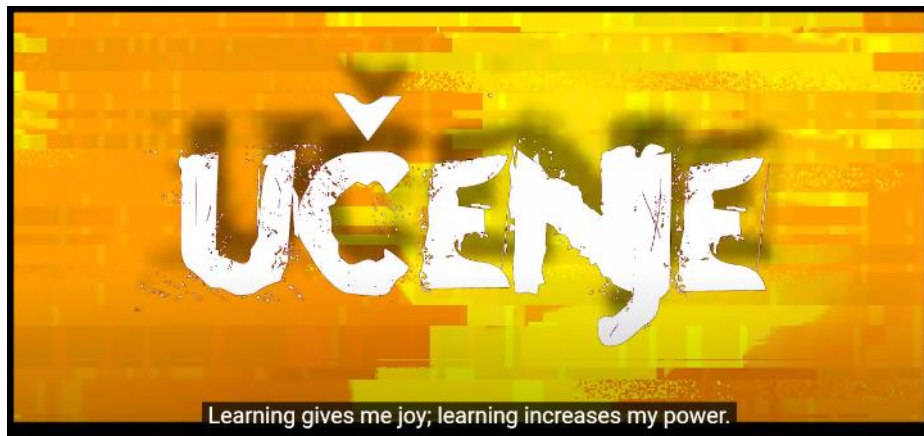
