



GETTING TO BRUSSELS

Brussels Airport is very close to the city – it takes around 20 minutes by train from the Brussels Airport to Gare Centrale (Central Station). The airport train station is located below the terminal (basement level-1). Up to 6 trains an hour connect the airport to Brussels Central Station. Tickets are on sale at the stations. A single fare costs EUR 8.90.

The city centre is also well connected by bus. The Airport Line (bus number 12) halts at the most important stops in Brussels.

Charleroi Airport is a bit further away from the city centre – it takes around 1 hour by shuttle from the airport to Bruxelles Midi (South Station). You can buy the tickets online.

GETTING AROUND

We recommend using public transportation in Brussels.

You can buy tickets from Kiosks, Bootiks (at the metro stops) and GO! vending machines.

Prices vary between 2,10 € (single fare) to 14 € (10 journeys).
