How would you like to contribute to the work of EAEA, based on the experience in your organisation? What capacities do you have to support the work of EAEA?

sTOP is a national organisation celebrating its 27th aniveraty this year, gathering more than 260 adult trainers, educators and activists mainly (but not only) from the NGO sector. We are actively working on the quality of the learning process in non-formal education. We have created and developed the system of certificates of quality in learning for trainers and educators acknowledged by many institutions in Poland that is shown as an example of innovation in non-formal education. Additionally, we are active in consulting documents regarding non-formal education policy in Poland on the national (governmental) level. sTOP learning philosophy is to spur adults and youth into action by delivering them a high-quality learning process.

I may contribute to the EAEA with my managerial, project and advocacy experiences.

Are there specific activities or areas of work at EAEA you would like to contribute to? Which activities or areas of work are you already actively contributing to?

My focus of interest is especially quality in non- formal ALE. sTOP has a long term experience in fostering quality measures in non- formal adult education sector via training educators and via certification system. Recently, we have invited EAEA to work together on a pilot project for ensuring quality in ALE on the European level.

I and sTOP team are also ready to support EAEA and different events, meetings and courses with relevant experts and facilitators as we gather more than 250 of them from across the country, working with different topics, in different languages.
